### ACO Growth & Landscape

#### **Total Number of Medicare ACOs**





More than **\$17B** in gross savings to Medicare through 2021<sup>2</sup>



**30%** growth in MSSP ACOs taking on two-sided risk since 2020<sup>1</sup>



#### **ACO** Reach Focus



#### • 132 ACOs participating in ACO Reach

- Improve the focus on:
  - Introduction of health equity benchmark adjustment
  - Requirement to collect demographic and social needs data
  - Increase range of services ordered by Nurse Practitioners to improve access



### **ACO Challenges**



- Strong quality improvement across chronically ill patients
- Appropriately stratifying their patient population and having disease specific interventions for those populations
- Difficulty engaging chronically ill patients in their care, outside of the traditional clinical setting
- Lack of actionable insights to drive decision making and referrals
- Moving the needle on health equity

### **Engaging Patients in Their Care**



- Empower patients through sustainable, positive behavior changes
- Deliver personalized care to motivate and engage patients
- Provide robust onboarding and engagement support to remove barriers to adoption



### **Empowering Care Teams With Data**



- Leverage clinical decision support, oftentimes within native workflows
- Streamline care coordination
- Identify and proactively intervene with at-risk patients
- Seamlessly identify and coordinate speciality referrals



### Equitable Health Care, Digitally-enabled



- Extend care to medically underserved and rural communities through remote monitoring
- Address potential environmental determinants of health at the patient level
- Remove barriers to technology or internet access
- Capture and report out on demographic and social needs data



### **Key Takeaways**
