



Why is Data Important to Risk-Bearing Care Programs?

Manage patient needs

- Emphasize integrated care.
- Treat the entire patient.
- Manage their physical, mental, behavioral, and social needs.

Stratify Risk

Classify patients into population cohorts based on varying factors

- Demographics
- Cost of Care
- Adverse Health Events

Benchmark Care

Compare performance against provider, organization or geographic-wide.

- Monitor quality metrics
- Measure intervention efficacy

Position patients at the center of decisions

Establish patientcentric processes




Be data-driven

Adopt an efficiency mindset. Improve quality vs. quantity.


- O Uncover vulnerabilities and optimization opportunities in your current processes
