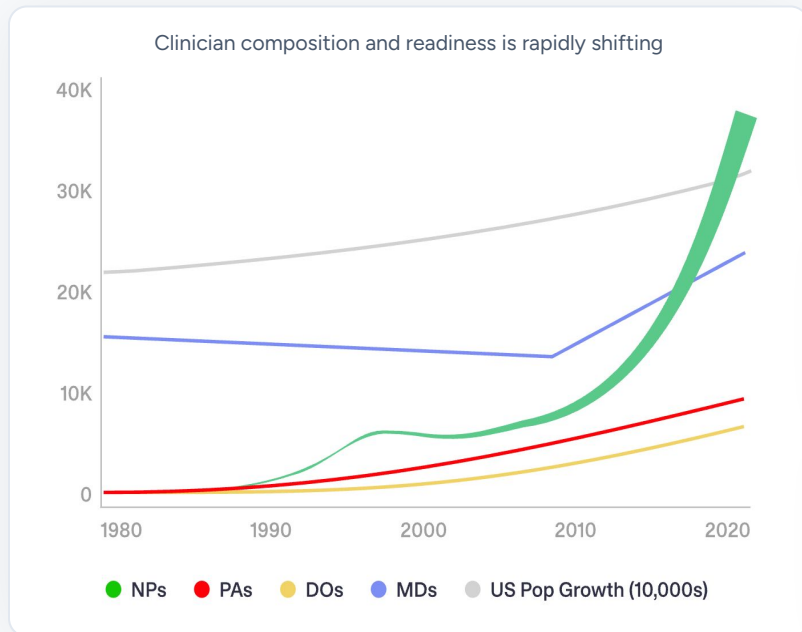
When outcomes stall adding people won't fix it

Why outcomes stall today — it isn't a people problem, it's a performance problem.

- PROBLEM

Outcomes hinge on provider execution and care plan adherence.
